Changing attitudes, knowledge and behaviour

Studies have demonstrated that, in some cases, pointing out inconsistencies between attitudes and behavior can redirect the behavior. In the case of the school supporter, showing that their actions (i.e., not voting, not attending parent-teacher organization meetings) are harming rather than helping efforts to improve education in their town may influence them to reevaluate their behavior so that it reflects their attitudes.

Attitudes and Behavior in Psychology

An attitude is "a relatively enduring organization of beliefs, feelings, and behavioral tendencies towards socially significant objects, groups, events or symbols" (Hogg & Vaughan 2005, p. 150) "...a psychological tendency that is expressed by evaluating a particular entity with some degree of favor or disfavor" (Eagly & Chaiken, 1993, p. 1)

The results of the tracking study were published weekly on the British Retail Consortium website for private member access. Attitudes are a construct of internal beliefs and value systems. Attitudes, capability or circumstance influence observed behaviour. Use caution when assessing attitudes and use behaviours as examples. Feedback and behaviour management can change attitudes. Changing attitudes can also change values and beliefs and vice versa.

The study of attitude-behavior consistency concerns the degree to which people's attitudes (opinions) predict their behavior (actions). Attitude-behavior consistency exists when there is a strong relation between opinions and actions. For example, a person with a positive attitude toward protecting the environment who recycles paper and bottles shows high attitude-behavior consistency.
